**Resolution Directing Preparation of a Generic Environmental Impact Statement Under SEQRA, Acknowledging Preparation of a Draft Scope, And Scheduling a Scoping Session**

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board of the Town of Fishkill is considering an update to the Town's Comprehensive Plan ("CPU"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board as lead agency in review of the CPU under the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA") ECL §8-0101 et seq. and 6 NYCRR Part 617, has issued a Positive Declaration; and

**WHEREAS**, it is now necessary for the Town Board to prepare an Environmental Impact Statement under SEQRA in regard to the CPU;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, as follows:

1. That a Generic Environmental Impact Statement (GEIS) will be prepared in regard to the CPU pursuant to SEQRA sections 617.9 and 617.10; and

2. That the Town Board, through its consultants, has prepared a draft scope for the GEIS on the CPU, a copy of which is attached hereto; and


3. That a scoping session on the GEIS will be held on December 21, 2022 at 7:00 PM; and
